

Angus Bowling Association Championship Rules

Angus Bowling Association Championship Rules as adopted at AGM on February 14th 2015 and all Clubs must abide by. (Rule 2 Amended)

Competition Rules

- 1 Players will be allowed to play in ABA Championships and in Seniors Competitions if 60 years of age or over on 1st of April on year of competition. (only one of each)
2. Dress will be:- White top or Club Coloured Top and Grey or Black Trousers, all players in team must wear same dress.
3. Substitutes will not be allowed in Singles Competitions
4. Each competition will be allowed the following substitutes
Fours = 3 Substitutes
Triples = 2 Substitutes
Pairs = 1 Substitute
- 4 Substitutes will not be Skip
- 5 If a player is substituted he will not be allowed to return to play in team.
- 6 No substitutes allowed after the Semi Finals
- 7 Special arrangements may be made for a player who has to be substituted as follows.
Family Bereavement or Jury Duty,
- 8 Championship games commence at 6.30pm, Senior's games commence at 2pm with fifteen minutes waiting time being allowed.
- 9 Seniors must be 60 years of age or over on 1st of April on year of competition.
- 10 If, owing to any reason, a game should be postponed, the game shall be played before the following Round. Failing agreement by both Clubs, the Secretary of the Association shall arrange a date, which shall be conclusive
